








FAVORITE GRAPHIC NOVELS


AMAZING SPIDER-MAN: RENEW YOUR VOWS by Dan Slott & Andy Kubert

THE SCULPTOR by Scott McCloud

Exploring questions of mortality, legacy, and what we are willing to sacrifice in the pursuit of art and love, The Sculptor was welcome introspection into the human condition in a year otherwise full of cataclysmic superhero battles and general sci-fi weirdness in the comics sphere. REVIVAL VOL. 5. by Tim Seeley & Mike Norton

The best book that you're not reading continued in vol. 5 this year. Perhaps you've heard that it's a "zombie story", rolled your eyes and shambled away. "Cain't be no better than the Walking Dead, sumbeetch!" you may have uttered. It was only later, after being exposed to the glorious Revival that you realized that you had become, in fact, a Kirkman Zombie. Read with an open mind and closed lips... The story takes place in a town in Wisconsin where the dead are returning. They come back perfectly fine, albeit a tad hard to kill, and continue about their business. No harm, no foul. The catch is...they are only coming back in that particular town. Imagine how the rest of the world would react to that, if you will... Of course, the book quickly turns into a horror story that's as good as anything Stephen King wrote in the '70's. Deftly written with art

THE HELLBOY 100 PROJECT TP by VARIOUS (and Jim Brozman!)

The Hero Initiative, a charity that provides help and assistance to comic book artists and writers in need, publishes a yearly volume. The 100 Project. The Hero Initiative sends out over 100 blank sketch covers to over 100 comic artists and they return them to the charity with drawings, sketches and paintings drawn on their covers. The actual comic books are auctioned off for the charity and a book is published annually featuring the artwork from all the covers in one volume. Proceeds from the published books also aid the charity. For this year's memorable volume, the comic book was Hellboy and the BPRD 1952 #1. The Hellboy 100 Project features artwork drawn by some of today's favorite artists as well as some very good new talents. I was fortunate to be asked to participate and I drew a cover that is included in this latest volume. APOCALYPTIGIRL: AN ARIA FOR THE END TIMES by Andrew MacLean


